



North Dakota Veterinary Medical Association's Animal Hall of Fame

The ND Veterinary Medical Association's Animal Hall of Fame is an annual program that honors animals and their caregivers who exemplify the strength and value of the human-animal connection.

Objectives

The goals of the North Dakota Veterinary Medical Association (NDVMA) in holding the Animal Hall of Fame Awards are:

- ❧ To honor the outstanding contributions our animal companions make to human lives.
- ❧ To heighten public awareness of the human-animal connection.
- ❧ To allow NDVMA members to share in the celebration of their patients' accomplishments.

Categories

Nominations are being sought in five categories:

- ❧ **Hero Award:** Animals who have saved or preserved human life.
- ❧ **Companion Award:** Animals who have provided a benefit to their human companions or their community.
- ❧ **Professional Award:** Animals specially trained to assist humans (seeing eye dog, therapy, etc.).
- ❧ **Working Award:** Animals specially trained to assist police, medical units, military, etc.
- ❧ **Survivor of the Year Award:** Animals that beat the odds of living.

Recognition

- ❧ Inductees will be recognized at the NDVMA's Annual Family Dinner, **Friday, Aug. 8, 2025 at the Cowboy Hall of Fame in Medora.**
- ❧ Owners will be presented with a plaque at the event and the animal will receive an appropriate token of recognition.
- ❧ **Animals and their owners are encouraged be available to receive the awards.**

Requirements

- ❧ Nominees must reside in ND.
- ❧ Each nomination must be on a nomination form, with the signature of the animal's owner.
- ❧ **A photograph of each animal is required.** Please submit digital photos to execdir@ndvma.com.
- ❧ Permission must be granted for NDVMA to use photos for award presentation and news releases.
- ❧ **A brief description of why the animal should be considered for induction into the NDVMA's Animal Hall of Fame must accompany the nomination form.** Explain how they exhibited special abilities when it mattered or made a difference; how the animal demonstrated unselfish or courageous accomplishments; or the ways in which the animal provided healthful benefits, socialization, etc.

Deadline

The nomination deadline is **June 19, 2025.**

Selection

Nominees will be reviewed by NDVMA's awards' committee.
